 - Technology-enhanced learning or traditional tools?

Motivation

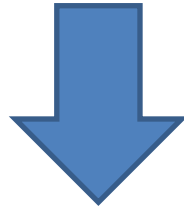
- There is **no „one size fits all“** solution for innovative instructional designs.
- We need to understand the teaching philosophies, **to provide tailored materials within ITEM.**

Objective

- To better understand the educational culture, teaching philosophies and use of educational technologies at the test institutions.
- Our Focus: On teachers

Approach

1. Semi-structured interview
with a representative of the math program
in test institutions and partner universities



2. Standardized, online survey of teachers in
all institutions

Step 1: Semi-structured interviews

- Organization of math lectures?
 - Organization of assessments?
 - Use of real-life examples in math lectures?
 - Use of mobile technology in math lectures?
 - Use of special software in math lectures?
 - Use of Moodle in math lectures?
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- Overall, 14 interviews are planned, 4 are already conducted.

Step 2: Online-based teacher survey

- Trigwell (2004); 16 items

2. Technology, Pedagogic, Content Knowledge (TPACK) Survey

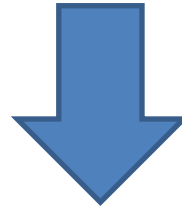
